

To experience the love and mercy of God is the goal of the 2025 Jubilee Year of Hope. The new of year of hope officially began when Pope Francis broke open the Holy Door (a symbol of the gate of heaven) of St Peter's Basilica on December 24th. The Eternal City

expects around 30 million visitors this year relating to the Jubilee events and festivities, some of which include the canonizations of Blessed Pier Georgio Frassati and Blessed Carlos Acutis. Jubilees have biblical roots, as the Mosaic era established jubilee years to be held every 50 years for the freeing of slaves and the forgiveness of debts as manifestations of God's mercy. This practice was reestablished by Pope Boniface VIII in the year 1300.

If we say we love God, we must be lavish in our mercy and forgiveness. We journey as pilgrims finding ways to heal others with our sincere charity, not placing unnecessary debts on others. God is calling us to step up the grace and pour on the mercy. Let us remember that hope does not deceive or disappoint because it is grounded in the certainty that nothing and no one may ever separate us from God's love (Romans 8). May our faith-filled efforts liberate any lingering gloom from 2024. During this Jubilee year, may our adventurous journey be filled with hope.






