Thank you for all the compliments on the new digital sign at St Francis. As a number of parishioners have said regarding the sign:

"It's about time!"

When I first arrived the summer of 2023, I admit I was underwhelmed with the signage promoting our church. I noticed the original concrete sign was located in the lawn, and a big tree covered most of it with low leafy branches. The small metal sign by the east central sidewalk was lacking in "curb appeal". All things considered, an upgrade was in order.

When the idea was first floated, it involved a rather tall marquee, one that was shaped just like the façade of the church. It was going to be made out of grey brick, and literally a tall project. Well... we were limited by Norton Shores' zoning ordinances. The height, overall width, size of the digital screen, and distance from the sidewalk are the result of all these city guidelines. After a few revisions, we brought down the initial estimate by tens of thousands of dollars and found a nice compromise. This outdoor sign features the latest technology in video pixelation (9mm) and allows us to reach our community with 5-second scrolling information about activities and faith. When Spring arrives, we plan on adding large colorful planters with various flowers. A few people have already asked if they can advertise their own events, but please note that we have to limit our content to church activities only. This sign was made possible because of your generosity in exceeding our CSA goal. I'd like to thank All Signs LLC for their expert work! They're located at 1005 W Laketon Ave, by Muskegon Catholic Central.

Stay tuned for the next enhancement that we hope to have in place by the end of 2025. I believe this next "piggyback project" will be well received!




