The confessional is a place of pardon and peace, where the priest welcomes you with kindness. The Lord is inviting you to answer the call to be humble and purify your mind and heart through sacramental confession. Remember it is the power of Jesus working through the priest. Penitents walk into the confessional wounded but are then sent out absolved from their sins to continue the path of Christ-like disciples.

Message of the Cross By Deacon Jim Cross

"The message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved, it is the POWER OF GOD."

With Ash Wednesday just a week and a half away, we are about to enter into one of my favorite times of the year, the liturgical season of Lent. No, that's not just because I'm a glutton for punishment. It's because I recognize that I NEED to spend some time, in an official organized way, to bring myself back to living the most pure and holy life that I can manage. While I am well aware of how often I fall short, I also recognize that the sincere attempt at holiness pleases God, while the failure to reach out to God would cause Him and me both great sadness.

As we prepare ourselves for that period of yearning and stretching toward God, I have a resource to share. The formation of deacons includes several years of catechesis through Notre Dame University's McGrath Institute for Church Life STEP program. But the STEP courses are actually open to anyone! At just \$50-100 per several week course, this flexible online, certificate program offers courses for Catholics and aspiring Catholics that cover every aspect of our faith. They have courses about various periods of Church history, all aspects of Catholic theology, doctrine, liturgy and Catholic Social Teaching, and a whole range of courses on Old and New Testament scriptures.
