

Do you accept your canonical election as Supreme Pontiff? By what name do you wish to be called? (These are the 2 questions that are asked of a newly elected Pope.)

The Papal Conclave is the special duty and specific right of the College of Cardinals to elect a successor to St Peter (see the Apostolic Constitution Universi Dominici Gregis). The maximum number of Cardinals is 120, and they must be younger than 80 years old. This solemn event takes place in the Sistine Chapel after a formal, solemn procession. The Cardinals who vote do so by secret paper ballots placed in an urn in full view of all present. The Cardinals who take an oath to be faithful to the voting process are intentionally isolated with the intention of avoiding interference to ensure a fair election. The voting begins no later than 20 days after the death of the previous pope. If a two-thirds majority is not reached, black smoke will emerge from the Sistine Chapel. White smoke signals the election of a new pope. When the newly elected Pontiff is confirmed, he immediately imparts the Apostolic Blessing (Urbi et Orbi: "to the city and the world") from the balcony of the Vatican Basilica. Stay tuned and remain prayerful! In all things, we must humbly submit to Divine Providence.
