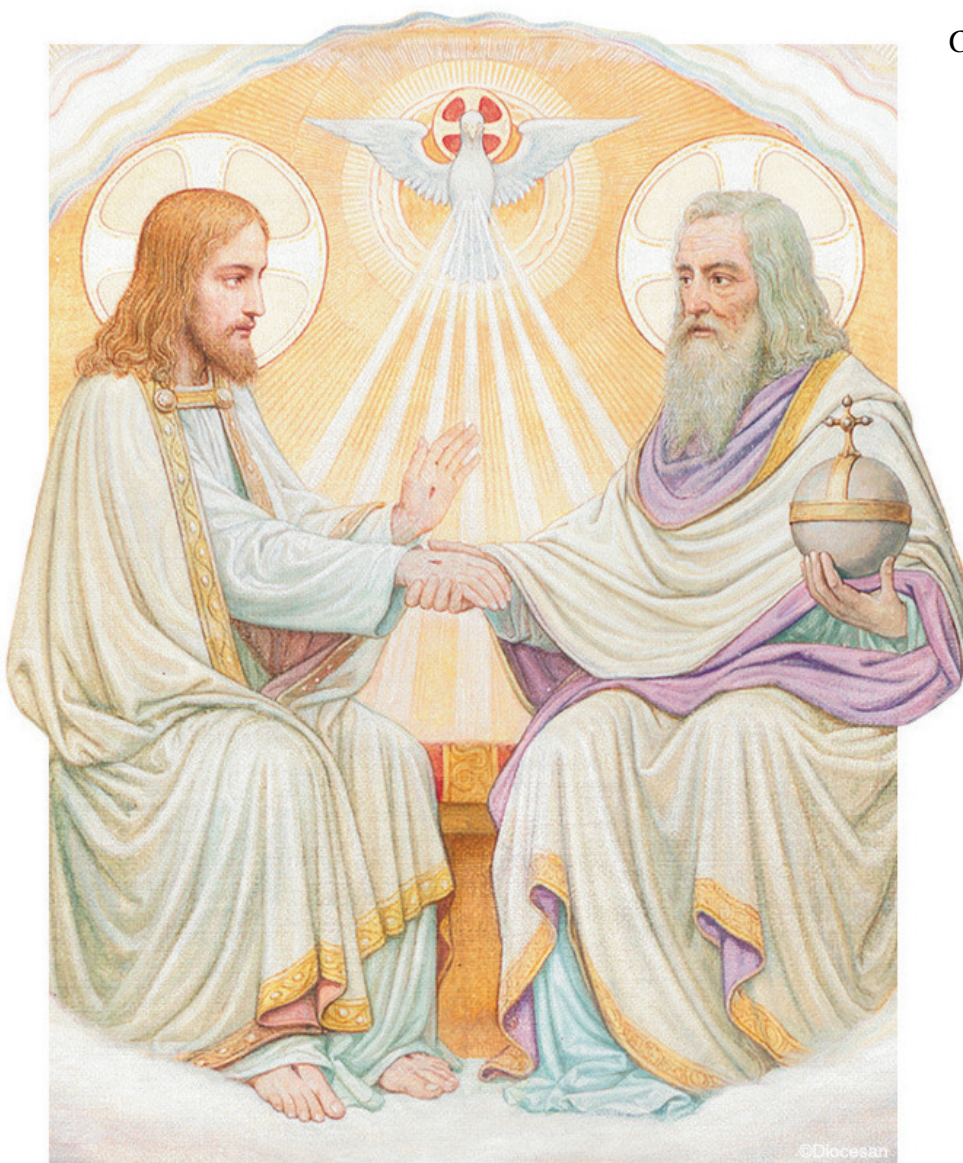

The Message of the Cross

The Holy Spirit animates us for a many faceted purposes. One facet is to elevate and sanctify our relationship with the Father through mass and other occasions of worship and prayer. In my opinion, we, as a parish family, embrace that facet quite well. Another, equally important, facet of our Spirit gifted purpose is to serve the physical and spiritual needs those around us, and most especially those less fortunate. While our worldwide and diocesan Catholic Church in many ways have that service down to a finely tuned machine (e.g. the Catholic Services Appeal), sometimes we Catholics can lose sight of the importance of this purpose for our own parishes and for each of us individually. But this facet of our Catholic Mission is every bit as important as the other one. St. John reminds us that "Whoever loves God must also love his brother, for how can someone claim to love God, who he cannot see, while he fails to love his brethren, who he can see?" (1 Jn 4)

So here are a couple of upcoming opportunities for each of us to embrace that purpose:

Welcoming Teams for St. Thomas Parishioners

We are putting together a team of parishioners from both St. Michael's and St. Francis to greet and meet briefly with St. Thomas parishioners after their masses on the weekends of June 21/22. As their parish holds its last weekend mass on June 29, their parish family will definitely need our consoling support and our welcome and encouragement to join another parish in the area. Here's where you can step in to be the hands, feet and voice of Christ to his people in need. Just call either parish office to get onto the team and plan according to the St. Thomas Mass schedule, Saturdays at 4-5pm and Sundays at 10-11am.

Joseph's Builders

During the July 5 - 12 mission week, Joseph's Builders will be renovating the home of Joyce Sorenson. Joyce is 90 years old, a widow and mother of 5. Three of her children have passed away and Joyce cares for another child who is unable to care for himself.

The mission team of 30 or more adults will engage in:

- Complete repair to roof damage and replace new roof.
- Interior structural repair due to water damage
- Kitchen repair
- Bathroom upgrade
- Minor cosmetics inside and out (including some landscaping)
- Storm window installation
- Front door repair
- Major tree work (removal and repair)

Joyce grew up attending St. Michael's Church, and her support needs far surpass what material relief the mission will bring. Our hope is to reconnect her to our local Catholic community not only for ongoing physical support, but for her spiritual support as well, by connecting her to the Sacraments again. Please begin praying for Joyce and please pray for the success of this Mission and for all participating in it to be open to the grace of God. Please consider joining other parishioners in providing drinks, snacks and even meals to the mission team throughout the week. They will be staying right at St. Michael's, and you can make those arrangements through the St. Michael's office.

P.S. St. Joseph's Builders is already beginning to plan and look for other local homeowners like Joyce who need help.
