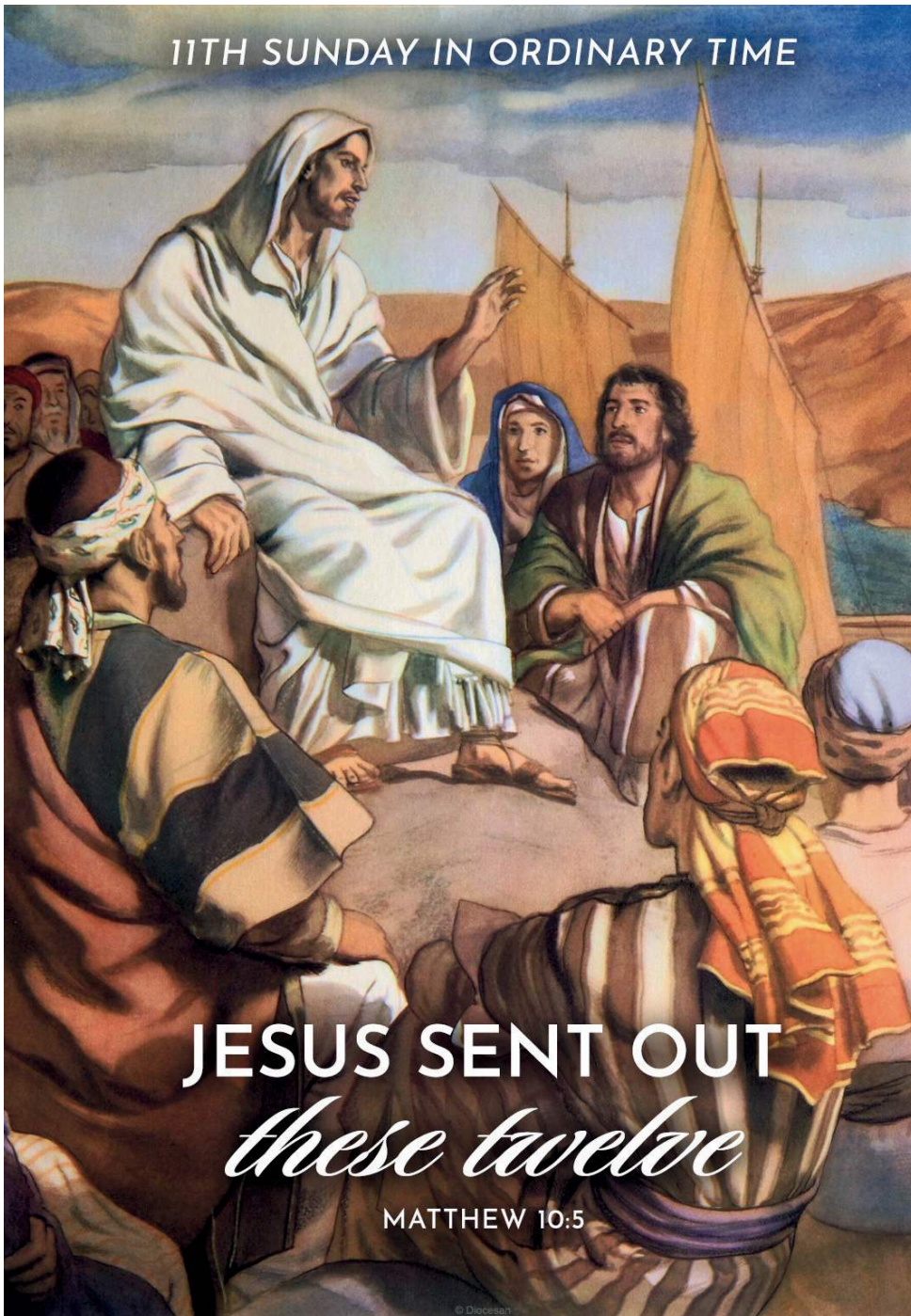

## ~ Communion Rails ~

Philippians 2:10-11

*“At the name of Jesus every knee should bend, those in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord.”*

Kneeling for Communion is not what I grew up with and was perhaps “before my time”. The removal of Communion rails began after Vatican II, but lost gems should never be forgotten.

Liturgical law allows communicants to receive the Eucharist while kneeling, and Communion (or altar) rails serve as a physical support for those who exercise this right. According to the General Instruction of the Roman Missal (GIRM), “standing” is the normative posture for receiving Holy Communion in the US. The GIRM protects the right of the individual to kneel, whether at a rail or to receive elsewhere.

While Canon Law neither requires nor prohibits rails, Liturgical law dictates that the faithful have the right to receive Communion on the tongue. I personally agree with traditionalists and liturgical historians who advocate that altar rails help facilitate receiving on the tongue efficiently and reverently, as it provides a few moments of reflection before reception, a stable support for kneeling, and better safeguards the Eucharist in its distribution.

**Beginning Sunday July 5th at St Michael, we will once again be using one side of the Communion Rail during the 9am Mass. If this appeals to you, be prepared to sit in the pews on the Ambo side. Please kneel along the rail. Yes, you are welcome to stand along the rail too. The other locations to receive the Eucharist will remain the same.**

On weekends at St Francis, a portable kneeler will be at the front step of the sanctuary for those who want to receive the Eucharist while kneeling. As many of you know, our weekday Masses already incorporate opportunities to kneel for Communion.

This is not a “medieval retrieval” but a “restoration of reverence”. Our aim is to receive the Lord reverently, whether on the tongue or in the hand. May God richly bless us for revering and worshipping the most Holy Sacrament of the altar!

***A round of applause for the ten hard working volunteers who helped this past Saturday to remove dead trees and fallen branches from the rectory back yard. We completely filled a large trailer, plus we gathered a separate pile of many branches, and stacked about 50 firewood logs.***
