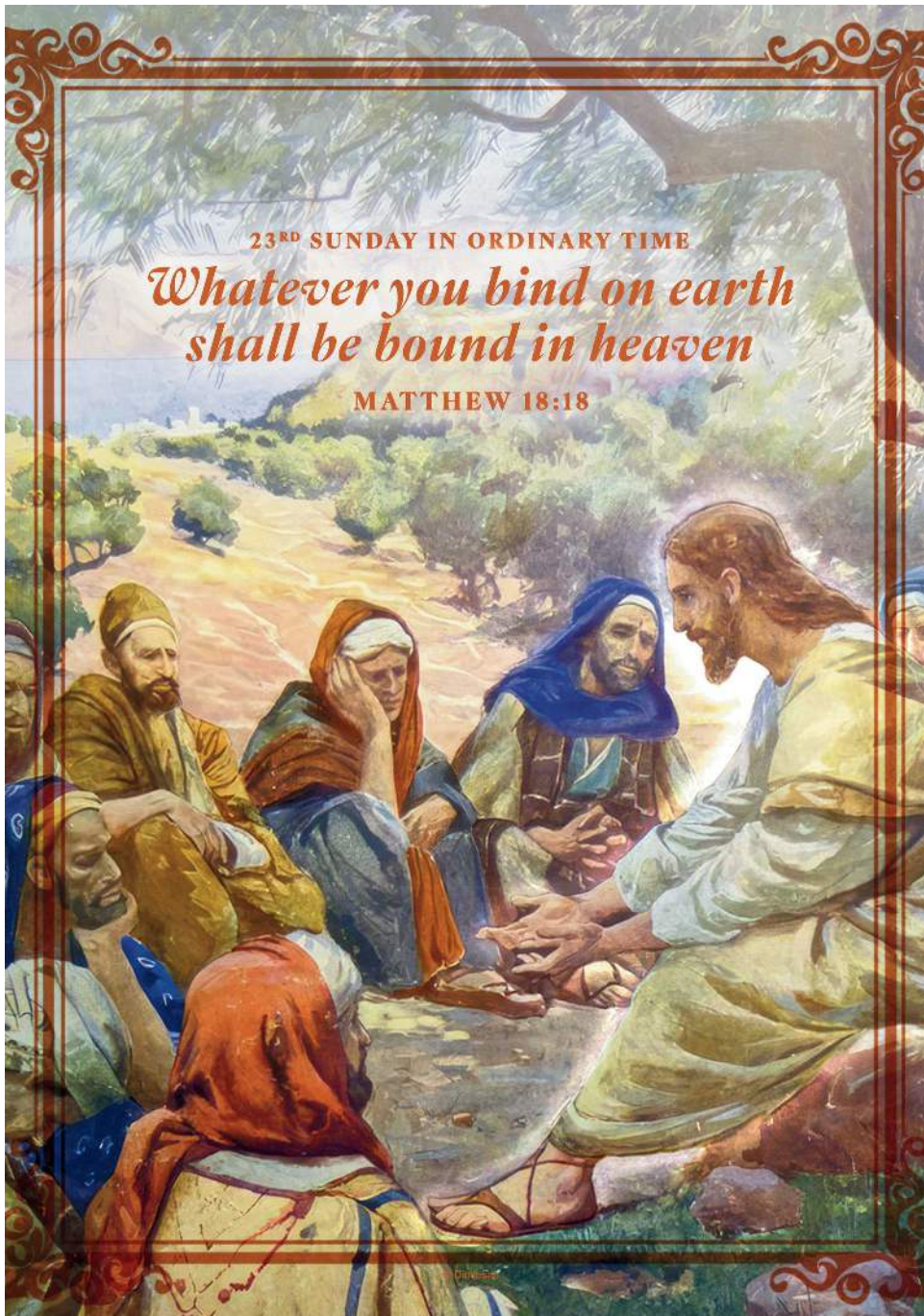

THANK YOU to all who helped to make the Rummage sale a success. The Original rectory rooms are cleaned out and we are on our way to having much more space for future retreats and ministries!

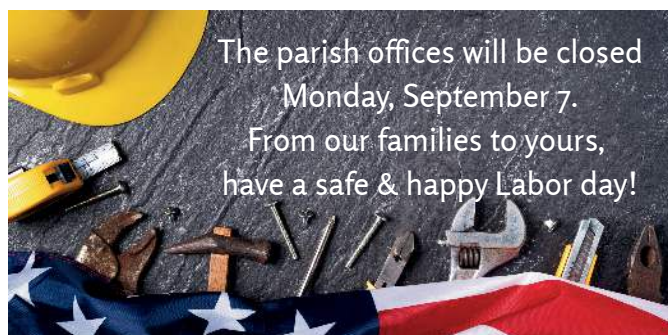
